Lalichan Zacharias to take legal advice in this matter pertaining to what actions IIA can take on behalf of its Members, since the matter pertains to Intellectual Proprietary Right and other laws, any action without legal advice may not be prudent.
- c. The 3<sup>rd</sup> suggestion related to steps needed to be taken by IIA to check continuing dwindling of the Profession of Architecture. The President invited suggestions from the Members in this respect. President also informed the house that he intends to write to Govt. of India, all PSUs, Govt. of various States, a letter requesting them to involve architects in various infrastructure development thereby increasing possibility of employment. The House appreciated this proposition.
