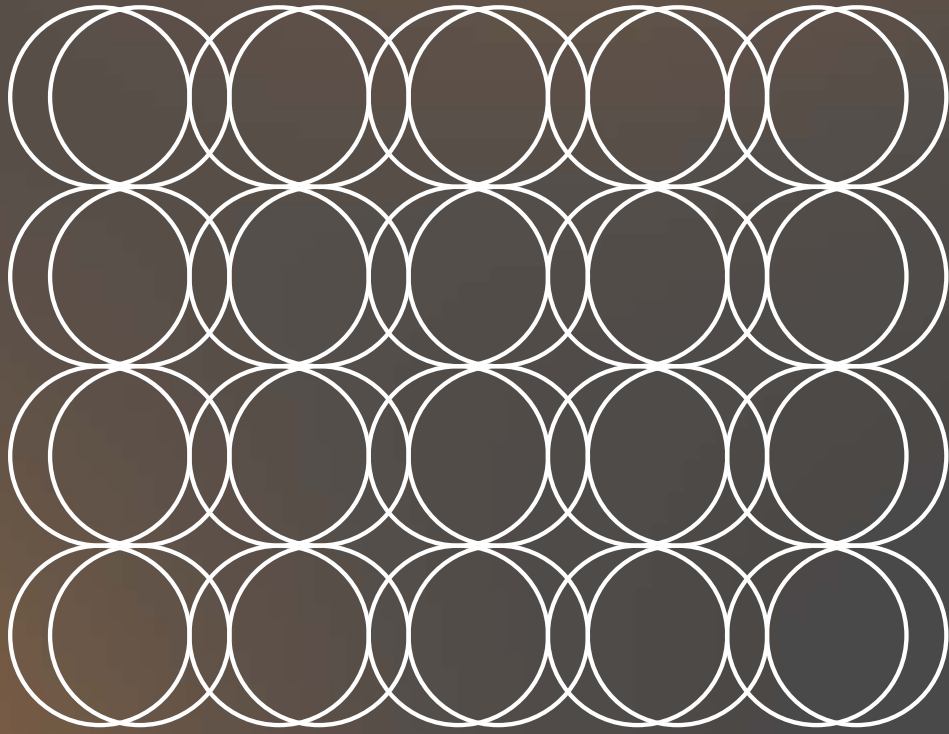

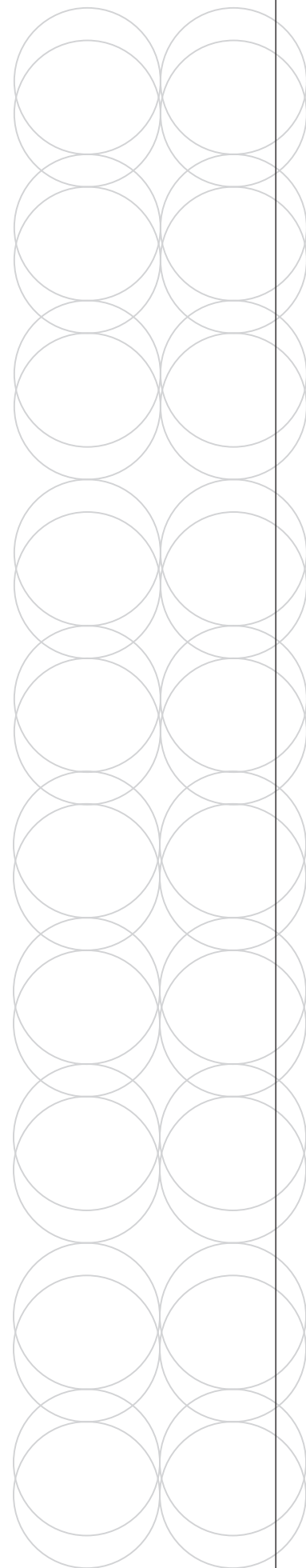

I am very happy to announce that, The Indian Institute of Architects is organizing its Annual National convention "NATCON 2020" in digital format for the first time ever.

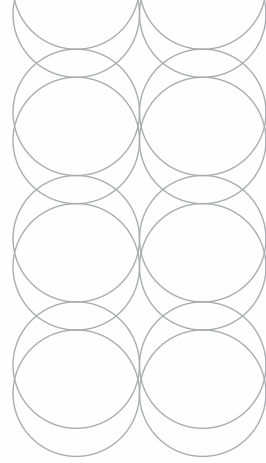
The theme of the convention is "Transcend" with focus on Self-Reliant, Resilient & Inclusive Architecture.

Eminent speakers & Panelists from across the world will be sharing their thoughts on this theme of Great topical importance.

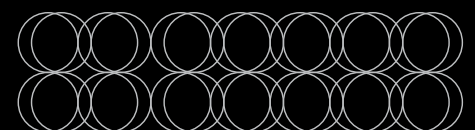

Ar. C.R. Raju & Ar. Lalichan & their entire organizing team have been working day & night for past more than month.

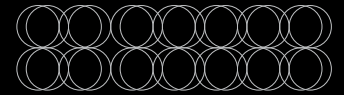
