NOTICE INVITING NOMINATIONS

IIA NATIONAL COUNCIL, CHAPTERS, CENTRES & SUB-CENTRES ELECTIONS TERM 2026 – 2028

Members of The Indian Institute of Architects (IIA) desirous of contesting the IIA National Council, Chapter, Centre and Sub-Centre Elections for the term 2026–2028 are requested to download the respective Nomination Forms attached herewith.

The duly completed and signed Nomination Form, together with all required annexures and supporting documents, shall be scanned and submitted by e-mail only to iaaelections2026.28@gmail.com on or before 5.00 p.m. (17.00 hrs) on Monday, 20 July 2026. Any nomination or communication sent to any other e-mail address shall not be considered for election purposes.

The subject line of the e-mail shall clearly indicate:

- IIA National Council / Chapter / Centre / Sub-Centre, and
- Name of the Post for which the nomination is being submitted.

Important Points to Note

1. IIA National Council Elections:

- For the post of President, the nominee shall be a Fellow Member of the Institute and must have served at least one full term as an Office Bearer of the National Council.
- For the posts of Vice President, Honorary Treasurer and Joint Honorary Secretaries, the nominee shall be a Fellow Member and must have served at least one full term as an elected National Council Member.
- For other posts, the nominee shall be a Fellow or Associate Member of the Institute.

2. IIA Chapters Elections:

- For the posts of Chairperson and Vice Chairperson, the nominees shall be Fellow Members and must have served at least one full term as an Office Bearer of the concerned Chapter.
- For the posts of Honorary Treasurer and Joint Honorary Secretaries, the nominees must have served at least one full term as an Executive Committee Member of the concerned Chapter.
- For other posts, the nominee shall be a Fellow or Associate Member of the Institute.

3. IIA Centres Elections:

- For the posts of Office Bearers, the nominees must have served at least one full term as an Executive Committee Member of the concerned Centre.
- For the posts of Committee Members, the nominee shall be a Fellow or Associate Member of the Institute.

4. IIA Sub-Centres Elections:

- For the posts of Office Bearers the nominees must have served at least one full term as an Executive Committee Member of the concerned Sub-Centre.
- For the posts of Committee Members, the nominee shall be a Fellow or Associate Member of the Institute.



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Common Points:

1. No Office Bearer shall hold the same office for more than two consecutive terms.
2. Every candidate contesting for the post of Office Bearer shall submit self-attested documentary proof of eligibility along with the nomination.
3. Every nominee shall submit self-attested copies of Aadhaar Card and PAN Card along with the nomination. If elected, these documents may be used for banking and other official purposes, wherever required.
4. The Candidate, Proposer and Secunder shall have paid their subscription as One time payment or at least up to the Financial Year 2028 on or before the last date of receipt of nominations.
5. A member may contest only one post. In the event nominations are filed for more than one post and the additional nominations are not withdrawn within the prescribed time, only the nomination for the higher office shall be retained and the nomination(s) for the lower office(s) shall stand cancelled.
6. Co-opted Members shall not be eligible to contest for the post of Office Bearer.
7. Members are advised to carefully read the Important Notes printed overleaf in the respective Nomination Form before submitting their nominations.
8. For any matter not mentioned above, the decision of the Scrutineers shall be final and binding.
